There are 2.9 million jobs in the creative economy and the UK's creative industries generate over £84bn per annum (that's almost £10 million per hour to the national economy).

The industry has long recognised the need to develop new and enthusiastic professionals to support the production of the performing arts and in particular to attract people from previously under-represented backgrounds in society.
