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A levy-paying employer's guide to the apprenticeship journey

Your Apprentice

You could receive additional incentives eg. £1,000 for employing a 16-18 year old apprentice.

Access Creative College is paid on a monthly basis from your digital account. 20% is held back for the end point assessment. You will pay any new apprentice's wage.

You should have already set-up a digital account into which levy payments will be paid. You can do this at www.gov.uk/guidance/payapprenticeship-levy Work out how much levy you'll pay each month, (0.5% of payroll over £3 million) using the HMRC online PAYE tool, or another free calculator. The Government adds 10%. Use your digital account to pay for apprenticeship training.

Agree the cost of the apprenticeship/s (paid from your digital account) and the duration of each programme (a minimum of 12 months).

Contact the NCCI's apprenticeship delivery partner, Access Creative College, who will help co-ordinate delivery, recruitment of an apprentice if required, and funding.

Decide which apprenticeship meets your business needs - either a new Standard or, until July 2020, a Framework. You could develop your existing staff through an apprenticeship, or recruit a new apprentice to grow your team.
